Nominees will be expected to possess the following qualities:

Essential

- An ability to make decisions showing strategic vision and tact, taking account of the charity framework within which Play Wales | Chwarae Cymru operates
- Leadership and management skills
- Ability to communicate effectively
- A deep understanding of the critical importance of play to children's development.
- An understanding of the strategic development of play provision in Wales
- An ability to promote the benefits of the provision of quality play opportunities.
- An ability to contribute strategically to the work of Play Wales, either in meetings or on specific working groups.
- Demonstrate the 'Nolan Principles' of public life: selflessness, integrity, objectivity, accountability, openness, honesty and leadership.

Desirable

- The ability to speak Welsh
- A background in financial management.

People who are disqualified from being Trustees of Play Wales | Chwarae Cymru include:

- Those who are discharged bankrupts
- Disqualified company directors
- Those who have unspent convictions relating to dishonesty
- Those who have failed to make payments under county court administration orders
- Those who have been removed by the Charity Commission for mismanagement
- Those under 18 years of age
- Those who have unsatisfactory criminal record checks.
